Subject: Implementation of Electronic Cargo Tracking System.

Accept my compliments and best wishes for the season. It's my conviction that all concerned authorities, shippers and transporting companies are enjoying our level of cooperation in regards to handling and transportation of South Sudan Cargos from different ports of charging to ports of discharge.

This official communication is to notify all concerned authorities, shippers and different transporting companies that facilitate safe conveyance of different categories of cargoes to final destinations in South Sudan that, South Sudan Customs Service entered into contractual agreement on **19th February 2019** with **ANTASER Afrique Limited** to implement an Electronic Cargo tracking System that include,

Maritime: From various ports of charging to the maritime Ports of discharge like; Mombasa, Port Sudan and other ports that handle our Cargos, and for all shipments to and from (transit cargo Inclusive), shippers are required to issue an **ETCN** in the ports of loading for cargoes for entering the Republic of South Sudan for purpose of customs clearance and submit to **Antaser International group for Validation**.

Each Bill of lading must be covered by at least one **ECTN**. The **ECTN** must be issued and validated at the loading port and or at the border and are elemental to import clearance by

South Sudan Customs Service. Any cargo with no valid ECTN will **NOT** be cleared through the local customs until clearance of fines and presentation of appropriate and valid ECTN is done.

Shipping liners are ordered to insert the **UNIQUE ETCN** number lines in the Bill of lading and cargo manifest. Failure to do so penalty or fines against the shipping lines amounting to **5,000 US\$** per infraction will be charged.

This measure will come to force as from the 1st April 2019

All shippers and forwarders are expected to register at the Antaser Afrique website www.antaserafrique.com or use their existing user name and password for their Antaser Afrique log in to start issuing ECTNs for South Sudan.
